was Glass.

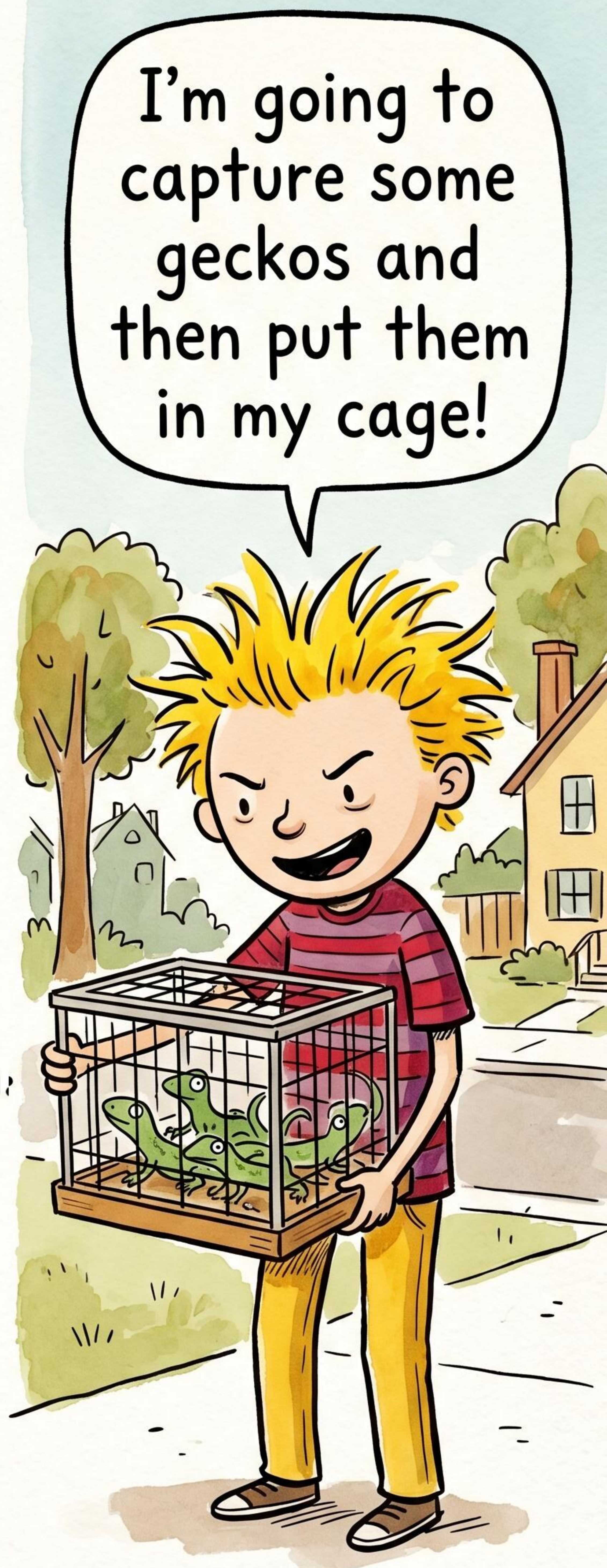
Glass's

honey.

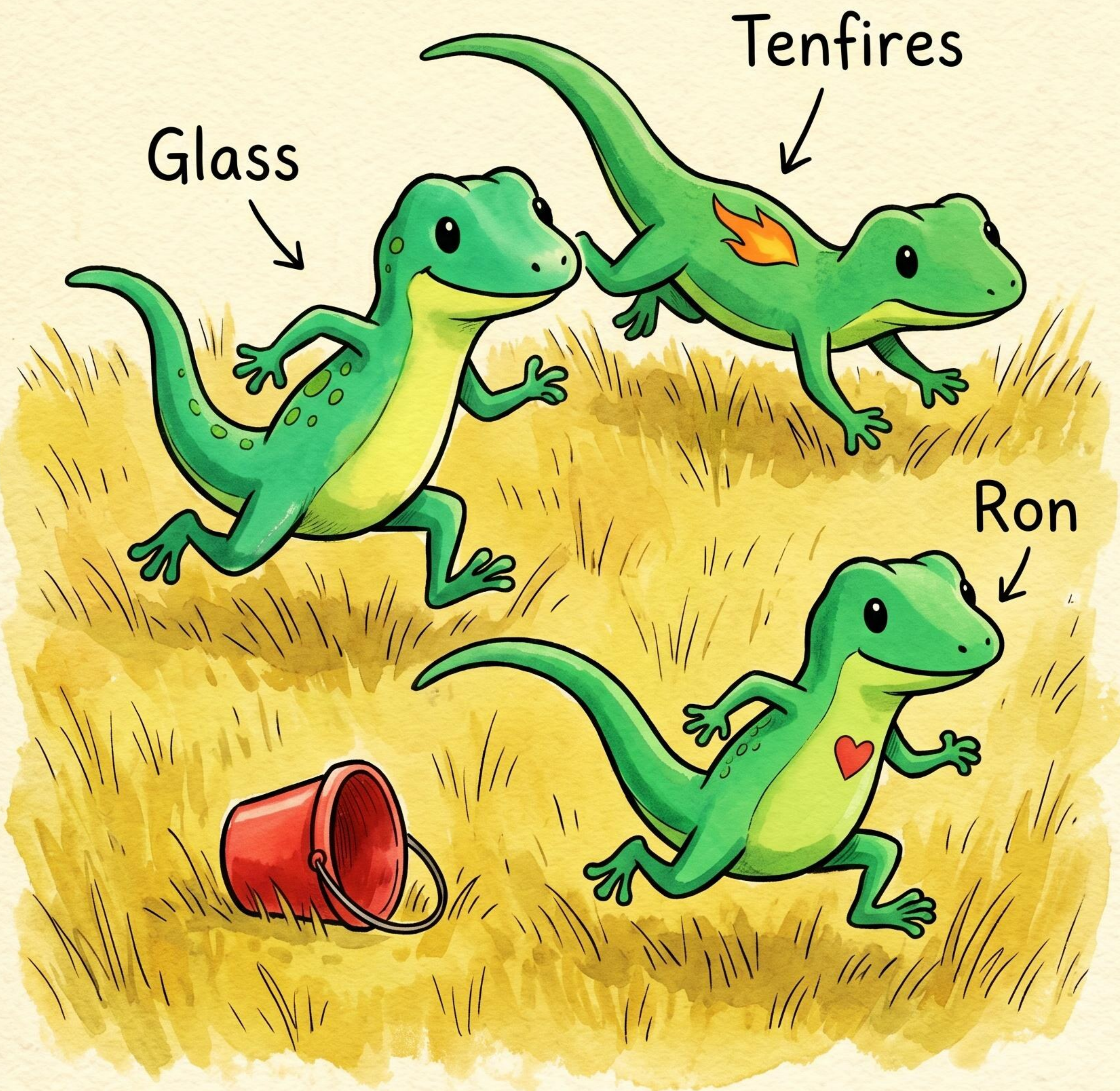


He loved to play with his

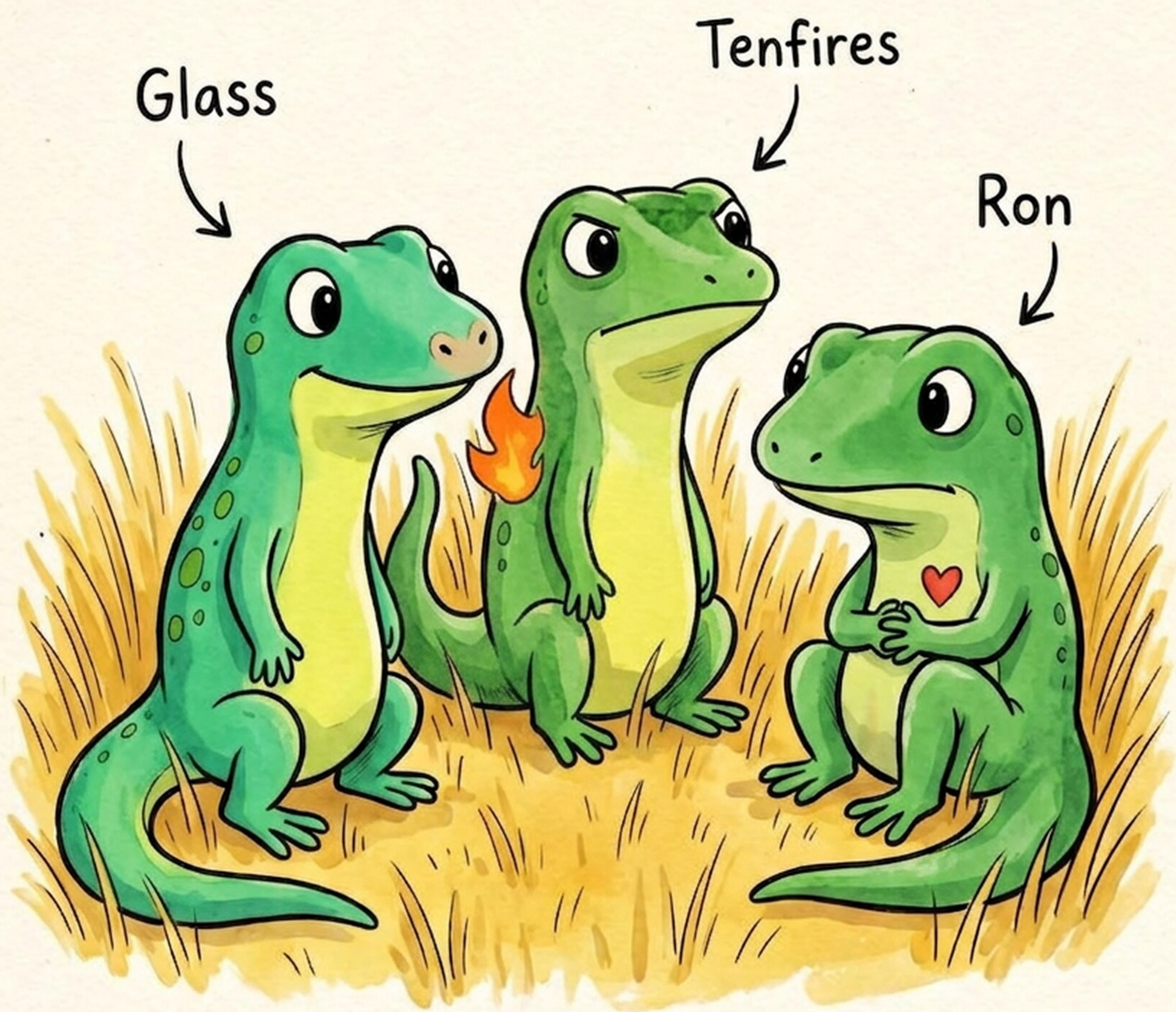




The geckos were always afraid of him. They would run away.

Ron was also gathering sticks.

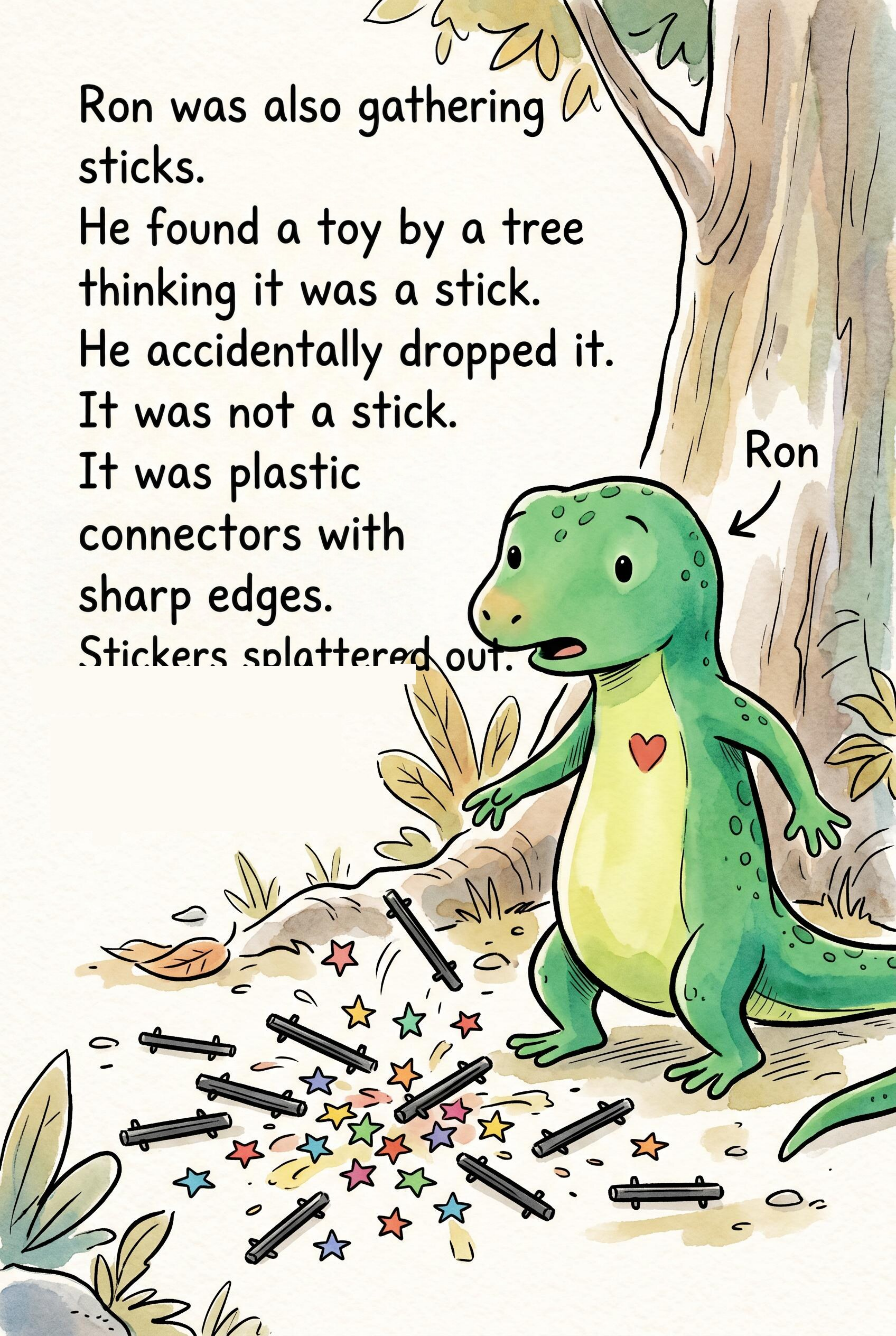
He found a toy by a tree thinking it was a stick.

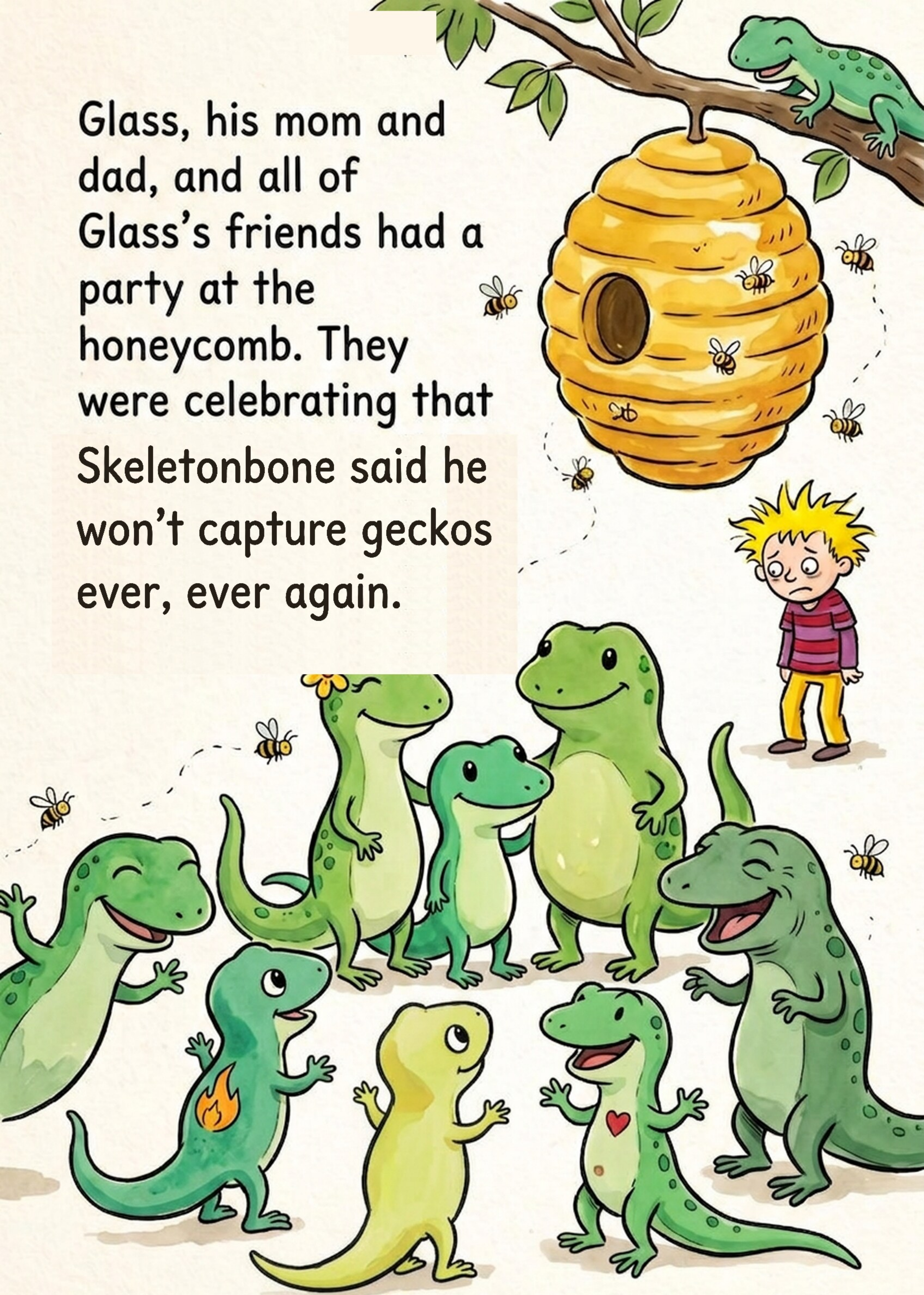
